I am honored to serve as the newest Deputy Director for the SFFEB. I was fortunate to intern at the SFFEB a year ago. I learned how invaluable we are to the Federal community by convening, communicating, and collaborating across agencies.

Before joining civilian employment, I was an active duty Service Member who concluded a 24+ year military career by participating in the DoD Skillbridge/Army Career Skills Program. These and other programs that help transition active duty military to civilian service are programs that I am passionate about. I retired from the Army in March 2021 and began work at EPA Region 9, where I had the privilege and responsibility of being the Regional Security Manager.

After graduating high school in 1996, I joined the Active Army and spent the next three years in Germany, where I also deployed to Bosnia and Herzegovina. In 1999, I joined the California Army National Guard as a Traditional Guard Soldier (1 weekend a month/2 weeks during the summer) to reunite with my family and community. Following 9/11, I was activated and deployed to Fort Huachuca, Arizona, for a year to provide homeland and installation security.

In 2003 I deployed again in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, where I was wounded in combat by an enemy mortar round. Following my return, I have worked full time for the California Army National Guard in administrative, human resource, operations, and varied middle management level leadership positions. In 2009, I deployed to Kosovo as the American Commanding General's Protective Service Non-Commissioned Officer-In-Charge.

After becoming a Commissioned Officer in 2011, I have had the opportunity to serve as the Executive Assistant (Aide de Camp) for the Commander of the California Army National Guardian Operations Manager; a Human Resources Manager; a Project manager; and finally culminating as a Human Resources Director of the most active Brigade in the State.

Concurrently, in 2014 I deployed to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, for nine months, where I was a Platoon Leader (supervisor of 35-45 personnel) and night-shift officer-in-charge of the maximum-security detention facility. Then from 2017-2019, I commanded a Military Police Company, where I led the 150+ member organization through four wild-fire responses; Santa Rosa, Santa Barbara, Yreka, and Redding, California.

In my time, I am a married father of three children and enjoy kayaking, fishing, making craft leather fantasy *faire* projects, and taking trips to my cabin in Montana.
